SHOW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

NRHA Approved Show. All riders must be a current 2024 South Australian Reining Horse Association Member to enter all classes. (Event memberships available).

Non-Sanctioned Classes (NS): Riders must be current SARHA Members. Non sanctioned classes are not subjected to horse licensing requirements. Membership proof must be submitted on Entry Form.

Sanctioned Classes (S): Both owners and riders must be current NRHA Members and SARHA Member. Sanctioned classes are subjected to NRHA horse licensing requirements (except Green Reiner & Para Reining classes). Proof of membership and horse licence must be submitted on entry form.

Show Entries Close: Friday 12th of April 2024 at 11:59 PM.

Entry Procedure: Submit an online entry via the SCRHA portal (<https://scrha.com.au/iump-login/>), One entry per horse/rider combination. Competitors must pay all fees associated with the entry via bank transfer to the SARHA bank account. Failure to pay the entry will result in the entry will not being recorded into the draw and will be returned to applicant/s, unprocessed.

By way of making an entry and payment of entries you are assuming responsibility for and binding owner, rider and/or agent to the terms and conditions as set out. By entering into the show, the exhibitor and its associates accepts and agrees to abide by all rules and regulations, terms and conditions of the show. Any accident, injury, concern, complaint is to be directed and addressed to show management.

Show Management have authority to enforce all rules pertaining to the show and all decisions will be final. Show Management may excuse any horse, exhibitor and or its associates from the show. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will be tolerated or accepted. Show management reserves the right to alter and amend the program and prizes/prize money at their discretion and without notice.

Late Entry: Late Entry is deemed 'Late' when a competitor entry that has not previously been entered has requested to be entered after the closing date of show entries (12/04/2024 at 11:59 PM). 'Late' entries will be accepted after the closing date however it will incur a late fee of \$25.00 in addition to all other entry fees applicable to the entry. 'Late' entries will result in the competitor being placed first in class draw. 'Late' entries will be accepted up to Wednesday 17th of April at 11:59 pm, At that point 'late' entries will be close for good.

Additional Entry: 'Additional' entry will be accepted for previously nominated horses and riders. An 'additional' entry will not incur any additional fees to all other entry fees applicable to the entry. 'Additional' entries will be accepted up to 6:00pm the day prior to the commencement of that class. 'Additional' entries will result in the competitor being placed first in class draw. Please notify Show Secretary for an additional entry.

Horse or Rider Scratching & Scratching Refunds: (*Show Secretary to be notified of a scratching*)

Prior Show, where entry is in process by show office and prior the class draw being posted: No Vet or Doctor certificate required, judges fee retained while balance of office fee and class entries will be refunded.

Prior Show, where entry has been processed by show office and the class draw posted: Vet or Doctor Certificate required, office fee and judges fee retained while the balance of class entries will be refunded.

At Show: No refund granted. Exhibitors that scratch a class for any reason after the draw has been posted will be liable for any and all fees incurred in connection to entering that class.

Class Draws: Will be available on SARHA Website and SARHA NRHA Jackpot and Added Money Show event page on Facebook, once all entries have been verified, no earlier than Friday, 19th of April 2024.

The working order will be run as per the posted draws. Competitors must report and be at marshalling area and be ready for their turn. If a competitor misses their turn as determined by the draw, they will be disqualified from that go round (except in unusual and unavoidable circumstances), the Class judge will determine each case at its own merit.

Media: Show competitors and spectators may be subject to the use of photographers and/or videographers under the direction of show management, the result of which may be used for SARHA.



SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

NRHA rules apply to all Sanctioned and Non-sanctioned classes except where otherwise indicated by SARHA Non-Sanctioned Class Rules. It is up to the competitors/owners to be aware of their eligibility and abide by the rules & regulations set by the NRHA 2024 Handbook and SARHA Non-Sanctioned Class Rules.

Showing: As per NRHA Handbook, A rider may not show more than three (3) horses in a NRHA Sanctioned class. If a rider rides more than one horse, there will be a spread of at least eight horses between the riders runs. When this is not possible due to a limited number of entries, the spread will be the maximum possible. A horse may be entered only once per class. In Para Reining, a rider cannot show more than one (1) horse in a class; however, a horse may be shown a maximum of two (2) times in the same class under different riders.

Concurrent Classes: Horses that are entered in more than one class in a concurrent class will only have one run and the score will count for these classes. Only one Judges fee is payable.

Prize Money: SARHA will retain 50% in jackpot and added money classes. Payouts will be in accordance with the NRHA Handbook payback schedule.

Ribbons & Prizes: Places will be awarded up to 3rd.

Attire: All competitors must wear western attire while showing, this includes a long sleeve shirt (can wear a jacket or vest over the top), jeans/chaps/show pants, boots, a western hat (no caps) or a safety helmet.

Class Presentations: In the view of good sportsmanship and as a mark of respect to the place getters the SARHA request that all competitors must attend class presentation; both horse and rider must be in appropriate western attire and horses saddled.

Competitor Numbers: Competitor numbers will be available at Show Secretary desk. Competitor numbers are to be placed on the nearside saddle pad, if number does not fit on saddle pad, it can be placed on riders back, as long as it can be seen. Competitor number must be displayed when showing.

As per NRHA Handbook, Failure to display the correct number or no number in a NRHA class will incur a \$25.00 fine. Failure to display the correct number or no number in a SARHA class will incur a \$5.00 fine.

Arena: No riding in the arena other than during the show and the times specified below.

Arena Open Pen: Open in the morning of each show day and will open at 6:00am and close at 8:30 AM. Open pen warm up rules apply. At the Lunch break there will also be an Open Pen in the Arena for the duration of the lunch break. Competitor numbers to be visible at all times when riding.

Warm Up Pen (Round Yard): The round yard is considered the warm up pen for competitors, it is reserved for the two horses and riders next in line to show.

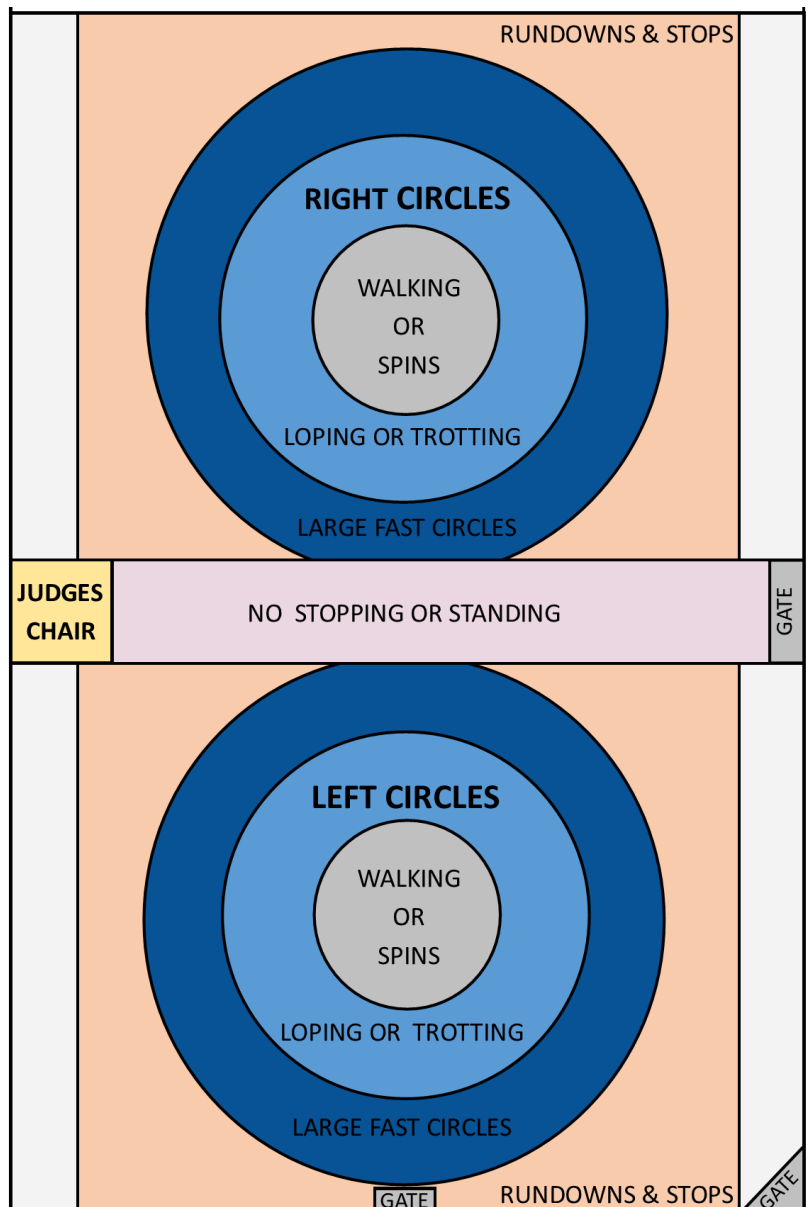

Open Pen Warm Up Rules:

- Please lope circles either to the Left or Right depending on which end of the arena the rider is at.
- Faster horses to the outside and slower towards the centre of each circle.
- When ready to change direction, please do so across the centre in a figure 8 pattern.
- Please respect other riders at all times.
- Approximately every 20 minutes, circles are stopped to practice run downs & stops for 10 minutes.
- When rundowns and stops are due, please make your way to the two short walls of the arena, and form a line across the fence. Take in turns running down the long side of the arena and perform a stop whenever is necessary.
- If entering during rundowns and stops please make way along the walls of the arena.
- If wanting to stop and rest at any time during the open pen, please make rest on the walls of the arena (Grey Area).

6:00– 6:20am = Circles
 6:20-6:30am = Rundowns & Stops
 6:30– 6:50am = Circles
 6:50-7:00am = Rundowns & Stops
 7:00– 7:20am = Circles
 7:20-7:30am = Rundowns & Stops
 7:30– 7:50am = Circles
 7:50-8:00am = Rundowns & Stops
 8:00– 8:20am = Circles
 8:20-8:30am = Rundowns & Stops
